

Pay-and-Display

CAR PARKS MARKED RED ON THE MAP

- **Nun's Close, Yorke Square and Round Howe**
long stay up to 10 hours.
- **Station Road**
long stay up to 10 hours, weekends and Bank Holidays only.
- **The Fosse (Richmond Falls)**
medium stay up to 4 hours.
- **Victoria Rd and Mercury House**
short stay up to 2 hours. Limited spaces.

Charges apply all year, from 80p for 30 minutes to £6.50 a day. Machines take coins (no notes) and don't give change. You can also use the RingGo app for Android or iPhone to buy tickets.

You can park overnight, but not sleep, in any of the above car parks, free of charge, but must display a valid ticket during chargeable periods.

■ A weekly ticket (£19.80)

Covers the Council-owned car parks above, and those in Hawes, Langthwaite, Hipswell, Leyburn and Muker. If you don't have 20 one-pound coins for the machine, you can buy a weekly ticket using the RingGo app.

Nun's Close car park has bays for longer vehicles, e.g. campervans.

Other controlled parking

GREEN ON THE MAP

The Station: £2.00 - £3.00, **medium stay** up to 4 hours. Free after 16:00 but no overnight parking. Machines take cards and coins.

Lidl: just 5 minutes from the Market Place.
Short stay up to 2 hours, free, for customers only. Buy an apple!

Blue Badge holders



- **Disc Zone** - designated bays adjacent to pavements; park in any bay if no designated bays available; no time limit.
- **Pay-and-Display car parks** - designated bays; usual time limits apply.
- **The Station** - 5 designated bays.

Toilets

Public toilets (open 08:00 - 18:00, cost 20p) are at **Nun's Close, Round Howe** and **the Fosse** (Richmond Falls). All have RADAR key access. Free toilets are available in the Market Hall and The Station during operating hours.

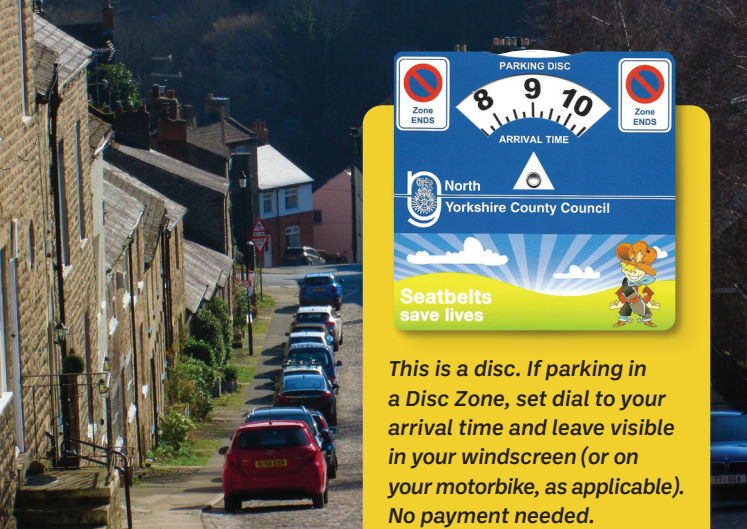

Car Parking in Richmond

(1 JUNE 2026)





This is a disc. If parking in a Disc Zone, set dial to your arrival time and leave visible in your windscreen (or on your motorbike, as applicable). No payment needed.

Disc Zone

BLUE ON THE MAP

Free disc parking for two hours between 08:00 and 18:00 in much of Richmond's Historic Centre. You may move to another street in the Disc Zone to start a new two-hour period; but if you want to park again in the same street, you should leave at least one hour before doing so. The Market Place counts as a street. Discs are free from most shops, and from Richmond Information Centre in the Market Hall. They may be used anywhere in North Yorkshire where disc parking operates.

Sundays: unlimited free parking; no disc needed.

NB: Bank Holidays are treated as normal weekdays, so you will need to show a disc!

EV Charging

Nun's Close car park has four 22 kW chargers for electric cars. They work with a simple tap of your credit/debit card. Don't forget to buy a parking ticket as well!
